

## Lime Energy Announces Award From Rocky Mountain Power

This award was presented to Lime Energy for saving the most kilowatt-hours (kWh) of any Rocky Mountain Power Trade Ally in 2007. Lime Energy efficiency projects are estimated to save over 5,000,000 kWh per year for Rocky Mountain Power’s customers which also equate to providing the following estimated annual environmental benefits:

- 9 million fewer pounds of Carbon Dioxide

- 114,286 fewer pounds of Sulfur Dioxide
  - the leading cause of **Acid Rain**
- 38,462 fewer pounds of Nitric Dioxide
  - the leading cause of **Smog and Acid Precipitation**
- 780 passenger **cars removed** from the road this year.
